	b. Does Acts give more information about how that commission was carried out and what was taught in fulfilment of that commission? Give an example.
3.	The book of Acts shows the mission of the Holy Spirit being fulfilled, and it answers questions as to who and how.  a. What promise did Jesus make about the Holy Spirit? (Jn 14:26, 15:26-27, 16:13-14; Lk 24:48 49)
	b. In what verses of Acts 1 does Luke write about the coming fulfilment of this promise?
4.	The book of Acts tells us about the church's beginning and growth as well as it work and organization.  a. Upon what did Jesus promise to build His church? (Mt 16:16, 18)
	b. What did the apostles preach, and what was the result? (Acts 2:36, 41, 47)
5.	The book of Acts helps us understand and gives more meaning to some of the things written in the epistles.  a. What did Paul give as a reason for remaining in Ephesus? (I Cor 16:8-9)
	b. What incident was he probably referring to? (Acts 19:1, 19-20)

  - d. What sources did the author have for the information he wrote in Luke and in Acts? (Acts 16:10-17; Lk 1:1-2) Who gave Him the words to write? (2 Tim 3:16-17)
  - e. What kind of person was Luke (e.g. character)? (Col 4:14; 2 Tim 4:11; Phm 24)
