- ELAM Province mentioned in Acts 2
- LYCIA Other provinces
- Roman Empire

Is the promise of Acts 1:4-8 fulfilled in Acts 2?

- Who
 - Ax 1:2...5...8
 - Ax 2:4, 16-17, 43
- Where
 - Ax 1:4
 - Ax 2:1, 5
- When
 - Ax 1:5
 - Ax 1:3-5; 2:1
- Why
 - Ax 1:8
 - Ax 2:4, 12ff

In Acts 2, did the power come only to the apostles?

- Antecedent of “they”
- Promise was to the apostles
- All Galileans
- The 12 spoke in tongues – 2:14
- We all (v.32) = they all (v.1) = apostles (1:20 ff)
 - Ax 1:2...5...8
 - Ax 2:4, 16-17, 43

Compare in Acts 2

Apostles	Hearers
Spoke - 2:14, 38	Listened - 2:14, 37
Answered - 2:38	Questioned - 2:37
Taught - 2:42	Continued in the teaching - 2:42
Worked miracles - 2:43	Were in awe - 2:43

Three miracles

- Sound as of a rushing mighty wind
- Tongues as of fire sat on each one of them
 - Not Mt 3:11
- Filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues
 - Tongues = known languages
 - Vs. 4, 6, 8, 11
 - Speaker
 - Wonderful works of God
 - Filled with Holy Spirit = Baptism with the Holy Spirit?
 - Speaking in tongues evidence of baptism with the Holy Spirit?

Tongues

- 3X in Acts
- I Cor 12-14
- Known Language
- Not learned
- Teaching
- Sign to the unbeliever
 - I Cor 14:22
- Accomplished both teaching and confirmation
- Compare to tongues of Pentecostalism
 - Gibberish
 - Instructions disobeyed
 - I Cor 14:22
 - I Cor 14:5, 19
 - I Cor 14:28
 - I Cor 14:27
