 - Redemption that is in Christ Jesus

God's favor
Undeserved and unearned by you and me

FOR THE LOST & THE SAVED

- The lost are in need of God's favor, but likewise the saved are in continued need of His grace
- Hebrews 4:14-16
- I Jn 1:6-9
- Acts 14:17

CORINTH

- Paul's apostleship challenged
- His authority & influence at stake
- I Corinthians 14:37
- Not an issue of personal feelings or self-promotion
- At stake: Acceptance of the apostles' doctrine
- Paul's apostleship proven
- Corinth: Boasting according to the flesh
- Paul: If boast, boast in my infirmities
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-10

A THORN IN THE FLESH

- "a pointed piece of wood; a stake"
- Numbers 33:55
 - · An enemy who would harass, annoy, cause trouble and pain
- Satan's goal: demise of your soul
- Infirmity weakness
- Reproach a wrong springing from insolence; injury; affront; insult
- Needs
- Persecutions
- Distresses gives place for anxiety, sorrow, pain
- Not sin

PERSPECTIVES ON THORNS

- A messenger of Satan
- Satan's purpose: destroy Paul spiritually
- Job:
 - Job 1:6-12
 - Job 2:1-7
- 1 Thessalonians 2:18, 16
- Spiritually discerned:
 - To buffet him strike, beat him so that he would not be exalted above measure
 - Keep Paul from pride
 - A teacher of humility

THE PRAYER & THE ANSWER

- Three times pleading for removal
- The answer No
- "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness"
- Pointed Paul to greater dependence upon the Lord
- Evidence of pride independence that confesses in attitude and deed – "I don't need God"
- Proverbs 30:8-9

- Verse 9
- Boasting in infirmities
- Corinth: boasting according to the flesh
 - Shame?
- Paul: take pleasure bear cheerfully

- Habakkuk 1:1-5
- Can we live without all the answers?
- We can!
- We must!
- Pray earnestly
- Accept the answer

SUFFICIENT GRACE

- Enough
- Fitting
- Will supply the need
- The strength necessary to the need
- A demonstration of His grace

A PROMISE OF GREAT VALUE

- Refining power

THE RIGHT DIRECTION
