


- * A servant

- Many things could have been questioned
 - * Desert road
 - * Mark 6:35
 - * Nevertheless
 - * Luke 5:5

- * Religious
- * A man of authority
- Not too proud to be taught
- * Acknowledged need of help and desire to be taught
- * Listened, learned, understood, believed, confessed, obeyed, rejoiced
