## Washing Away Sins

  - \* <sup>13</sup> For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, <sup>14</sup> how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?




## \* Acts 2:38

# Peter in Lydda & Joppa 9:32-43

- \* Lydda NW of Jerusalem, toward the Mediterranean Sea, on the SE end of the plain of Sharon
- Joppa on the seacoast of the Mediterranean, NW of Lydda
- \* Qualities of the miracles
  - \* The situation was known, real and obvious to others
  - The cure was obvious and complete
  - \* The cure was immediate, not over months or years
  - \* The miracle served its intended purpose vss. 35, 42
- Sorrow in verse 39
  - \* Acts 8:2
  - \* 1 Thessalonians 4:13

## Acts 10 – Significant to You and Me

- \* "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations..." Matthew 28:19
- \* "For the promise is to you, and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call." Acts 2:39
