Scriptures often present ideas built on ideas

- 1. Ascertain what is NOT being said
 - Warning of the Untaught
 - Not knowing what other Scriptures say
 - The Unstable
 - Unstable: not grounded in truth
 - Refusing to apply other Scriptures first
