A-millennial: the 1,000 years are not literal

What Began the 1,000 Years?

(An Angel) laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years

The Binding of Satan

John 12:30-33 (2 Corinthians 4:4, Ephesians 2:2)

Matthew 12:28-29 (Isaiah 53) c

Hebrews 2:14-15



Conclusion:

The 1,000 years began with Satan's binding

Jesus bound Satan at Calvary

This time began AD 33



What Describes the 1,000 Years?

Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; over these the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years. (vs 6)

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How the Saints Reign With Christ

And from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

Revelation 1:5-6 (NKJV)

"Kings and priests" = basileus and hiereus

How the Saints Reign With Christ

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

1 Peter 2:9

"royal priesthood" = basileus hieteuma

Conclusion

The 1,000 years are described as Christians serving God In King-Priest Service

Christians serve God in Christ in that way now:

Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.

Satan's release

Figurative of his constant power

Satan's Fate

The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Why is it Called 1,000 Years?

The number "1,000" is used figuratively in the OT:

Joshua 23:10

1 Chronicles 16:15

Job 9:3, 33:23

Psalm 50:10, 84:10, 105:8

A great amount that need not be measured

Why is it Called 1,000 Years?

2 Peter 3:8-12

1,000 years is not an actual measurement

It represents a great amount of time

Understanding Revelation 20

When Jesus arose from the Grave:

He bound Satan and took his authority away

Saints became priest-kings

When Jesus returns:

Death's last power is removed

We will be judged and receive our reward

The Second Death: Literally in Hell

And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

The First Resurrection:

having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised up with Him through faith in the working of God, Colossians 2:12

The Second Resurrection:

In order that I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.

Philippians 3:11

The First Resurrection: **Baptism**

having been buried with Him in baptism, in which you were also raised up with Him through faith in the working of God, Colossians 2:12

The Second Resurrection: Literal Resurrection

In order that I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.

Philippians 3:11

Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection (BAPTISM). Over such the second death (HELL) has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.
