



What is important = the purpose of a church

Purpose: Why are we here? For what reason?

What Is The Church's Purpose

Is it up to a church to determine its purpose?

- Making itself larger (fiscal and numeric)
- Merging a social and spiritual need
- Solving social problems

Churches with self-determined purposes:

Sardis and Laodicea (DEAD!)

What Is The Church's Purpose

Should a church determine purpose priority?

Making a purpose the sole priority

Danger – focus on one to the neglect of others

Churches with mis-focused purposes: Ephesus, Pergamum, Thyatira (SICK!)
