- Herod the Great
 - Matthew 2:1; 19
 - 62 BC to 4 BC
 - 9 wives
- Herod Antipas, son of Herod the Great
 - Matthew 14
 - Galilee and Perea
- Herod Agrippa I, grandson of Herod the Great
 - Acts 12
 - All of Palestine
- Herod Philip, son of Herod the Great
 - Matthew 14

John Mark

- Acts 12:12
 - Mary his mother
- Acts 12:25
 - Went from Jerusalem to Antioch with Saul & Barnabas
- Acts 13:5
 - Assistant to Saul & Barnabas on first preaching trip
- Acts 13:13
 - During the trip, departed to go back to Jerusalem
- Acts 15:37-41
 - Went with Barnabas to Cyprus
- 2 Timothy 4:11
 - Paul asks Timothy to bring Mark with him, for he is useful to Paul for ministry
- Colossians 4:10
 - Cousin of Barnabas (NKJV)
- Philemon 24
 - A fellow-laborer with Paul (Philemon written from prison in Rome)
- 1 Peter 5:13
 - "my son"
- The Gospel according to Mark

- True or False: All who live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.
 - ✓ 2 Timothy 3:12
 - Does it help to know this?
 - Don't get tripped up by it
 - Don't be discouraged by it
 - ✓ 1 Peter 4:14–16
 - Benefits of persecution?
 - Draw closer to God
 - Refine character
 - Strengthen faith

- What should the church do when one of their number is being persecuted?
 - Shrink back, hide?
 - ✓ Be quiet?
 - Be violent and fight back?
 - Revenge?
- Pray!
 - ✓ Why?
 - ✓ James 5:16
 - ✓ Philippians 4:6–7
- What should the church do when one of their number is in danger, sick, etc?
 - Pray!

- God does not always answer prayer the way we expect.
 - Did Peter expect miraculous deliverance from jail?
 - Did Rhoda expect it?
 - Did the saints expect it?
- We can pray for a specific answer, but the answer may not be what we expect
 - Can we accept it?

- Peter was not told to go right back into the frying pan.
 - And he didn't.
 - ✓ In Acts 5:20, he was told to go back into the temple and preach.
- Look for trouble? No.
- Shrink from controversy? No.
- Stand for what is right? Yes.

- Herod's character:
 - ✓ Dishonest Acts 12:18–19
 - ✓ Proud Acts 12:23
- God will take care of the dishonest and proud in His way in His time
