

King Jehoshaphat 2 Chronicles 18-19:2

- vs 1—Jehoshaphat allied with Ahab
- vs. 2—Ahab treats him royally
- vs. 3—"I am as you are, and my people as your people; we will be with you in the war."
- vs. 4—Jehoshaphat asks to inquire of the Lord
- vs. 5—Ahab asks false prophets
- vs. 6—Jehoshaphat asks if there is a prophet of the Lord
- vs. 7—There is, but I don't like what he prophesies
- vs. 12—Micaiah is brought and told to speak encouragement
- vs. 13—Micaiah will only speak word of the Lord
- vs. 14—Micaiah mocks Ahab
- vs. 15—Ahab demands he tell the truth
- vs 17—Ahab doesn't like the message
- vs. 22—Micaiah tells truth from the Lord, and calls out those who didn't
- vs. 23—Prophet of the Lord slapped and mocked
- vs. 28—Jehoshaphat disobeyed the Lord and went to battle with the wicked
- 19:2—Jehoshaphat helped the wicked and loved those who hated the Lord
