How to treat those who have been withdrawn from

In regards to fellowship...

- When a Christian is no longer walking in the light, they are no longer in fellowship with God. It is because of their non-repented sin
- And because they are not in fellowship with God, we can't have fellowship with them. We are to withdraw ourselves from them

It is a time of sadness and mourning:1 Cor 5:1-2

Commands to withdraw ourselves

- Matt 18:17 Let him be to you as a <u>heathen/tax gather</u>
- Rom 16:17 <u>Avoid, turn away</u> from them
- I Cor 5 Purge out, <u>not keep company</u>, <u>put away</u>
- 2 Thess 3 <u>Withdraw yourselves</u>, <u>do not associate</u>
- Titus 3:10 <u>Reject</u> a factious man
- 2 John 9-11 <u>Do not receive him</u>
- Eph 5:1-21 <u>Do not participate</u>, <u>have no fellowship</u>
- 2 Cor 6:14-7:1 <u>Do not be bound together</u>, what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness
 - 1 Tim 6:5 Withdraw yourselves

Who should withdraw from the disorderly?

- Saints/the church: Rom 16:17 Avoid, turn away from them
- <u>The church</u>: 1 Cor 5 Purge out, not keep company, put away
- <u>The church</u>: 2 Thess 3 Withdraw yourselves, do not associate
- Saints/the church: Titus 3:10 Reject a factious man
- Saints: 2 John 9-11 Do not receive him
- <u>Saints/the church</u>: Eph 5:1-21 Do not participate, have no fellowship

<u>The church</u>: 2 Cor 6:14-7:1 – Do not be bound together, what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness
 <u>Saints/the church</u>: 1 Tim 6:3-5 – Withdraw yourselves

Who should withdraw from the disorderly?

- The whole church
 - Not just the people that think they should withdraw
 - The command to withdraw is to the Saints who walk in the light
 - Those who refuse to support this effort:
 - Does not respect the authority of Christ
 - Does not love the erring as he should
 - Is not interested in keeping the church pure and free from worldly influence

How should we treat the disorderly?

We are trying to save them

- James 5:19-20 Turn him back to the truth, saves his soul
- Matt 18:15-17 If he listens to you, you have won your brother
- Galatians 6:1 Restore him
- We are to avoid (turn aside), not associate (socialize) or keep company with them in order to shame them (2 Thess 3:14)
 - Rom 16:17 Turn away from them (avoid)
 - 1 Cor 5:9,11 Not to associate with them
 - 2 Thess 3:14 Do not associate with him

Treat them not as an enemy but admonish as a brother – 2
 Thess 3:15

We must love them and continue to warn them of their error

How should we treat the disorderly?

- Be kind and love them
 - Eph 4:32 Be kind to one another
 - John 13:34-35 Love one another
 - 1 Cor 13:1-7 Love is kind
 - Agape love Acts in the best interest of others
 - Philos/Phileo love Friendly, tender affection, brotherly love
 - We are not to love them in this manner but only by whats best for them
- Seek to restore them Gal 6:1 Restore with gentleness
 - Be willing to forgive them
 - 2 Cor 2:6-8 Forgive and comfort him
