

- Begins with following bad counsel
 - Devoid of spiritual discernment
 - Wicked
 - Perverted
 - A little tainted with error
- Continues in evil-doing
 - "You have your way, I have mine"
- Leads to all out assault on the way which is right
 - Proverbs 17:15
- Sin enslaves
 - Hosea 4:11
 - Isaiah 5:18
 - 2 Timothy 2:16, 26; 3:13

Therefore, stand fast! 1 Corinthians 16:13

 - Rooted, built up, established *in the faith*
 - Acts 20:32
 - Give you an inheritance
 - Ephesians 6:16
 - Withstand the wiles of the devil

2 Timothy 3:16-17

- Likewise, today there will be trouble without attention to the law of Christ!
 - Religious error and division, immorality and worldliness
- Here's an alternative to law:
