# Acts 27 – The Continued Providence of God


- Left by early Fall
  - Made it to Crete by the time the Fast was past
    - 27:9-10
    - Day of Atonement Sep/Oct Lev 16:19
- Dating
  - Festus: begins as governor in A.D. 60 (secular history)
  - Arrived Rome Spring A.D. 61
  - 2 years in prison there 28:30
- Paul a prisoner for some 5 years A.D. 58–63
- Paul's desire to go to Rome
  - Romans 1:9-15, 15:24
- The Lord's promise
  - Acts 19:21
- A child of God in ordinary and extraordinary circumstances




### The Journey to Rome



### Example of Alexandrian ship






## Acts 27


