

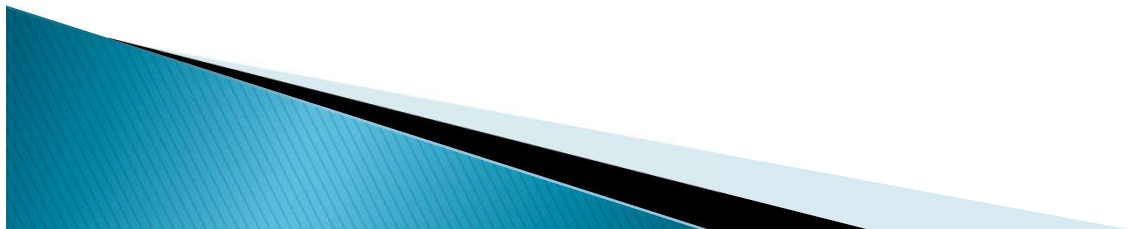
Acts 26

 - Paul says King Agrippa knows about these things regarding Jesus
 - Paul's question to Agrippa

 - Persuade Me
 - To become
 - A Christian



Acts 27 – The Continued Providence of God

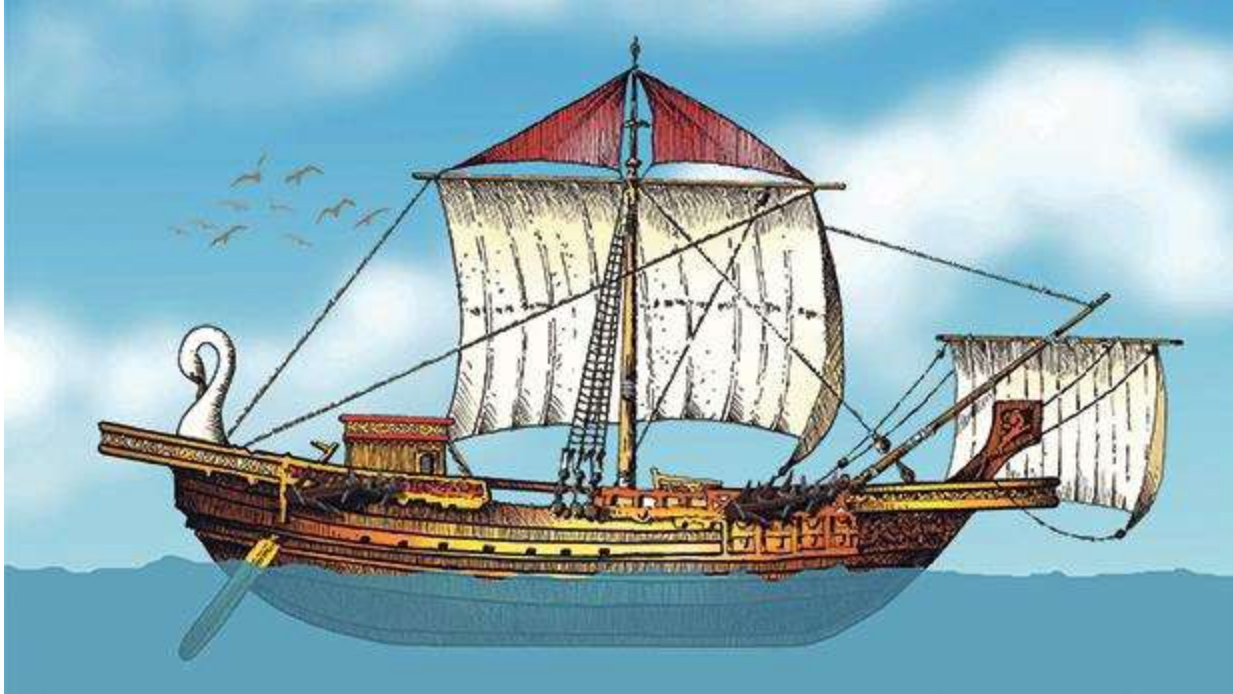
- ▶ Left by early Fall
 - Made it to Crete by the time the Fast was past
 - 27:9–10
 - Day of Atonement – Sep/Oct – Lev 16:19
- ▶ Dating
 - Festus: begins as governor in A.D. 60 (secular history)
 - Arrived Rome Spring A.D. 61
 - 2 years in prison there – 28:30
- ▶ Paul a prisoner for some 5 years – A.D. 58–63
- ▶ Paul's desire to go to Rome
 - Romans 1:9–15, 15:24
- ▶ The Lord's promise
 - Acts 19:21
- ▶ A child of God in ordinary and extraordinary circumstances

Example of Alexandrian ship

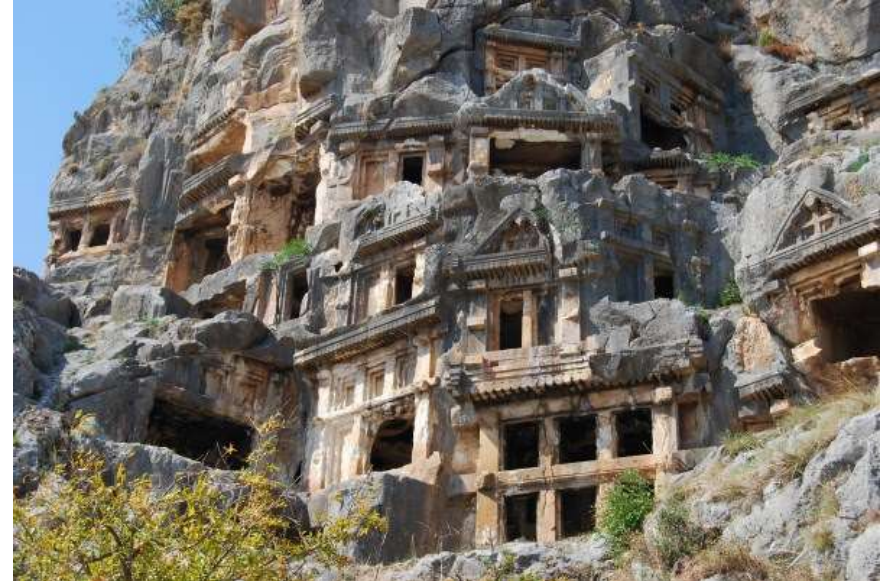


Acts 27

- ▶ “We”
 - 27:1–28:16
- ▶ Also Aristarchus
 - 19:29; 20:4; 27:2
 - Colossians 4:10
- ▶ Sidon
 - Phoenicia – 15:3, 21:3
- ▶ Sailing season
 - Dangerous season – Sep 14 to Nov 11
 - Nov 11 – Mar 10 – sailing ceased



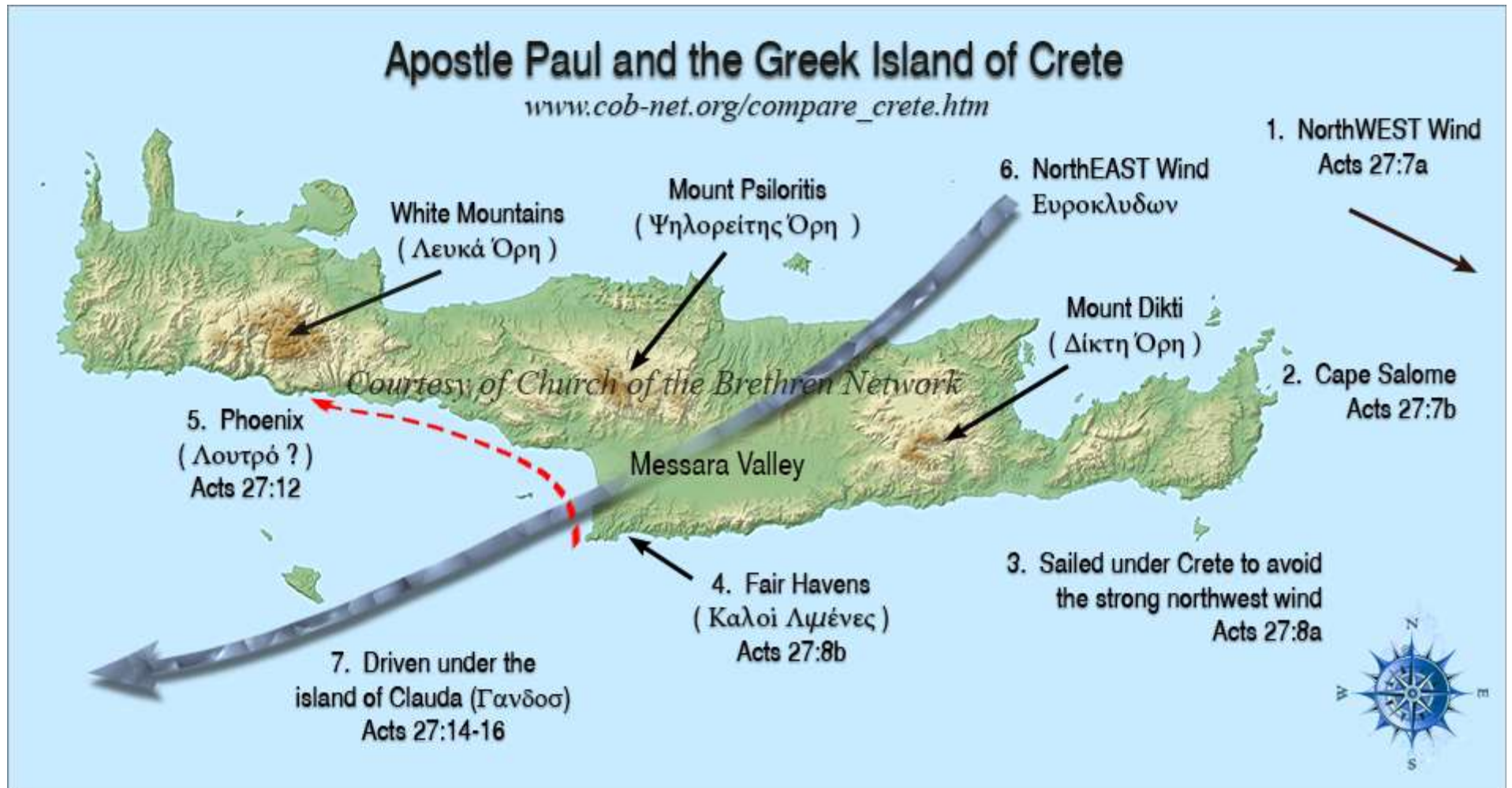
Ruins of Myra
