



Two Patterns of Forgiveness

For the One Outside of Christ

- One must hear the gospel
 - Corruption: Irresistible grace
- One must believe the gospel
 - Corruption: Faith only; sinner's prayer; infants
- One must repent
 - Corruption: Keep you unlawful wife
- One must confess Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the living God
- One must be baptized
 - Corruption: Denominational baptism, or no baptism

For the One In Christ, the child of God

- Acts 8:12-24
 - One must repent
 - One must pray
- 1 John 1:5-2:2
 - One must confess his sin to God
- Corruptions
 - Once-saved-always-saved
 - “Continuous cleansing”

By faith: teach and practice:

- The one outside Christ must hear, believe, repent, confess, and be baptized in order to have his sins remitted
- The Christian who sins must repent and pray, confessing his sin to God, in order to be forgiven
