



Conclusion

- Bible instruction comes in both generic and specific ways
- Generic authorizes specifics
 - "When the pattern circumscribes a general class or action, the specifics in that general class or action are authorized." (Steve Fontenot, lesson: Generic and Specific Authority)
- Specific does not authorize its generic
 - "However, when the pattern delineates a specific class or action, only that specific class or action is authorized – NOT the general class or action of which it is a member, nor other specifics of that general class." (ibid.)

Conclusion

 In determining what we are authorized to do, we should be as general as God has been in the Scriptures, and as specific as God has been in the Scriptures.

 Let us respect both the generic aspects and the specific aspects of the language of the Scriptures.

Lesson 10: Expediency

- **☐** Objective of this lesson:
 - ☐ Men sometimes want to justify doing a thing religiously by saying it is an expedient. Let us understand the role of expediency in determining what *is* and what *is* not authorized.
 - ☐ For example, some may misuse it this way:
 - ☐"It is expedient to sprinkle this disabled person instead of baptize them"
 - ☐"It is expedient to organize a missionary society in order to spread the gospel more effectively"

Expedient as used in the New Testament

- Expediency is a Biblical concept
- The word expedient as an adjective and noun is found in these scriptures: John 11:50; 16:7; 18:14; 1 Corinthians 6:12; 7:35; 10:23, 33; 2 Corinthians 8:10; 12:1
- Vine: "to be an advantage, profitable, expedient" (Vine's Expository Dictionary of New Testament Words, p.218)
- "characterized by suitability, practicality, and efficiency in achieving a particular end: fit, proper, or advantageous under the circumstances" (Webster's Third New International Dictionary)
- Key thoughts: helpful or profitable in expediting or carrying out a command

Expedients & Authority

- Something that is expedient must first be lawful
 - o 1 Corinthians 6:12; 10:23
- Something that is expedient must be within the realm of what God has authorized.
 - Israelite could not say it is expedient to take a female from the flock (Exodus 12:1-3), for God has <u>specified</u> a male.
- Something that is expedient should be something that edifies and does not tear down
 - 1 Corinthians 10:23-33


Something that is expedient should facilitate the accomplishment of God's will and be in harmony with His word – by His authority.

Examples of an expedient

- Genesis 6:14
 - o Tools
- Ephesians 5:19
 - Memorize, books, overhead displays, handouts



Ephesians 5:19

- Method to sing the same thing
 - Memorize, books, overhead displays, handouts
 - These are all specifics authorized by the command to sing, speaking to one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs
 - But is memorizing the songs expedient if not all can memorize the song?
 - Memorizing is authorized, but it would not be expedient if all cannot memorize the song.
 - We are operating in a realm of choice regarding the method to sing the same thing
 - We must consider the principle of expediency to determine the most advantageous method

Not an Expedient:

- Use of instruments in worship to God
 - "We will sing and play an instrument of music. The instrument helps with and is profitable to our singing."
 - O What's the problem?
 - The New Testament command to sing is specific as to type of music. Instrumental music is another type of music. It is a different specific within the general class of music and is thus not authorized it is not lawful. In order for a thing to be an expedient, it must first be lawful.

Not an Expedient:

- Use of the church's funds to care for non-saints:
 - "Using the church's funds to help needy non-saints will expedite be advantageous to – our being able to teach them the gospel"
 - O What's the problem?
 - The New Testament teaching of the church helping the needy is specific to needy saints. The needy of the world are a different specific within the general class of people. God gave the specific – needy saints. The needy of the world are a different specific and are thus not authorized, not lawful. To be an expedient, a thing must first be lawful.
