Acts: The church's mission

- Cannot find the church:
 - Providing social meals
 - Providing entertainment
 - Trying to resolve and effect change of national or political or social issues and evils
 - Providing charitable aid to non-saints
 - Attracting hearers with carnal tactics

- The gift of the Holy Spirit
 - 2:38

 - 13:52
