Adorning the doctrine of Christ...

- Every age
 - Older Men – 2:2
 - Older Women – 2:3
 - Young Women – 2:4
 - Young Men – 2:6
- Every relationship
 - In Christ – 2:7
 - Family Relationship – 2:4-5
 - Community Relationship – 3:2
 - Civil Relationship – 3:1
 - Economic Relationship – 2:9-10

How do we adorn the doctrine of God?

- Slaves – 2:9-10
 - Obedient
 - Well-pleasing in all things
 - Not answering back
 - Not pilfering
 - Showing all good honesty
- More broadly – 2:11-14
 - Soberly – relationship to self
 - Righteously – relationship to others
 - Godly – relationship to God

Why should we adorn the doctrine of God?

- The grace of God teaches us to – 2:12
 - We are His own special people!
- The power and profitability of adorning the doctrine – 2:7
 - “Be thou an example”
 - Lead others to salvation so that they may glorify God

What are the consequences of not adorning the doctrine of God?

- The word of God will be blasphemed
 - 2:5
- The people of God may be spoken evil of
 - 2:8
- Cannot expect to exhort and convict those living contrary to it
 - 1:9
