

Jesus' Teaching About the Coming of the Kingdom

- Mark 1:14, 15
 - The kingdom is at hand
- Mark 9:1
 - Kingdom would come in that generation
 - The kingdom would come with power
- Acts 1:8
 - Power would come when the Holy Spirit comes
- Acts 2:1-4, 33
 - The Holy Spirit came on the day of Pentecost
- Therefore, the kingdom came on Pentecost

The church's beginning was prophesied

- Isaiah 2:2-3
- Micah 4:1-2
- Joel 2:28-32
- Note these key words:
 - In the latter days
 - The Lord's house
 - All nations, many nations
 - The word of the Lord from Jerusalem

The church's beginning was prophesied

- House of God
 - A description of the church of God
 - 1 Timothy 3:15
 - 1 Peter 2:5
 - Ephesians 2:19
 - Fulfilled
 - Acts 2:47
- Latter days
 - Joel 2:28-29....Acts 2:16-17
 - Fulfilled: "this is that"
 - Days, not day. An age.
 - Last days included the "beginning"
 - Acts 11:15
 - Hebrews 1:1-2

The church's beginning was prophesied

- From Jerusalem
 - Luke 24:47-49
 - Fulfilled:
 - Acts 1:4, 8, 12; 2:1
 - Acts 2:37-42 (law went forth from Jerusalem)
- All nations
 - Jew & Gentile
 - Luke 24:47
 - Ephesians 2:6, 11-13, 16
 - Fulfilled:
 - Acts 2:5; 10:34ff
 - Taught:
 - Acts 2:39

The Pentecost of Acts 2 Was the Beginning

- Acts 11:15
- Beginning of the church
 - Acts 2:47; 5:11; 8:1; etc.
- Beginning of the preaching of the gospel that includes remission of sins
 - Acts 2:36-39
 - Could only begin after the Lamb of God was slain
 - Revelation 5:9, 10
 - Acts 20:28
- Beginning in Acts 2 (verse 47), the church – the kingdom of God – is spoken of as in existence
 - Acts 2:47
 - Colossians 1:13-14
