# Each description of the church shows authority and rule involved

- The church is "the called out," people called out of darkness and into the <u>service</u> of the one who called them
- Ephesians 5:24; Colossians 3:24; 1 Peter 2:9
  The church is the kingdom of God and includes a king and subjects and law
  - 1 Corinthians 9:21; Acts 2:36
- The church is the body of Christ, and a body has members <u>subject</u> to the <u>Head</u>
  - Colossians 2:19; Ephesians 5:24
- The church is the household of God, having a <u>Father</u> and <u>children</u> in <u>subjection</u> to their Father
