 - Vicarious = that which is done for another, in the place of another
 - Judged as smitten by God
 - John 9:1-2
 - But it is we who have sinned

 - He has borne our griefs
 - Luke 5:31-32
 - Carried our sorrows
 - Matthew 5:3-4
 - Wounded for our transgressions
 - Psalm 22:16
 - John 19:37
 - Transgression = go onward, beyond authority;
 rebellion

 53:1-3 – His reception

- 53:4-6 His vicarious suffering
 - Bruised for our iniquities
 - Iniquity = lawlessness; from a word meaning to bend, to twist, to distort
 - The chastisement for our peace was upon Him
 - Chastisement = punishment
 - 2 Corinthians 5:21
 - Colossians 1:20
 - By his stripes we are healed
 - Stripes Blows that cut in
 - Healed Restored to harmony with God
