Paul's Manner of Life

- Humility
- Pure in Motive
- Self-sacrificing purpose
- Supporting the weak

- To do what?
 - Finish his race
 - "that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God" (v.24)
 - A commission from Jesus: Acts 26:16-18
 - An apostle and a minister to the Gentiles
 - 1 Corinthians 9:24-27
 - 2 Timothy 4:7
 - 1 Corinthians 9:16
 - Duty compels!

- Some keys to maintaining his commitment:
 - Determined
 - "And see, now I go bound in the spirit to Jerusalem" (v.22)
 - In spite of knowledge of coming trouble (v.22-23)
 - Romans 15:30-32
 - Matthew 16:24-25

- •Some keys to maintaining his commitment:
 - 2) Immovable
 - "None of these things move me" (v.24)
 - Refused to be moved
 - John 15:18-21
 - Matthew 10:22
 - Hebrews 13:6
 - 1 Peter 4:12; 5:10
 - 1 Thessalonians 3:3
 - Colossians 1:23
 - 1 Corinthians 15:58

- Some keys to maintaining his commitment:
 - 3) Treasure in the right place
 - "Nor do I count my life dear to myself" (v.24)
 - Valued the right thing
 - Revelation 12:11
 - Ephesians 5:29
 - Philippians 1:20-21
 - 2 Corinthians 4:16-18

- To finish his race
 - Determined
 - Immovable
 - Treasure in the right place

- The faith in Christ
 - "Testifying...repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ" (v.21)
- •Acts 19:8; 18-20; 26:19-20
- Faith: John 8:24; Acts 4:12
 - 1 Peter 4:17
- Repentance: Luke 13:3; Acts 17:30
 - 1 Corinthians 6:9-11

- See Paul's teaching
 - The whole counsel of God
 - Innocent of the blood of all men (v.26)
 - Hows
 - "For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God" (v.27)
 - Let us see the necessary inference
 - "I kept back nothing that was helpful, but proclaimed it to you..." (vs. 20)
 - Did not shrink from

- The whole counsel of God
 - Acts 18:6
 - (physical need Proverbs 3:27-28; 1 John 3:17)
 - But, in this case, hold back spiritual truth that is needed?
 - No way.
 - Mark 10:21
 - Ezekiel 3:16-21
 - Jeremiah 6:13-14
 - Isaiah 30:8-11
 - 2 Timothy 4:1-5
 - Colossians 1:28

- Warning beware
 - Be on guard for 3 things
 - Trouble coming in from the outside
 - Trouble coming in from the inside
 - Defections
 - Colossians 2:8
 - 2 Timothy 2:17-18

- See Paul's teaching
 - Watch & remember loving warnings
 - *Watch, and remember that for three years I did not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears" (v.31)
 - •2 Peter 1:12
 - 1 Peter 5:8

- Be devoted to the word of God
 - "And now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified" (v.32)
- 1 Corinthians 15:1-2
 - The gospel:
 - By which you are saved
 - If you hold fast that word
 - Contains facts, commands, warnings, promises
- 2 Peter 3:17-18
- 2 Timothy 3:16-17
