"...How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it? Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life"

"Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures."

1 Peter 1:22-23

"Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever..."

"But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered"

 - It means that you obeyed that form of doctrine
 - 1 Corinthians 15:1-4
 - Romans 10:16
 - "obeyed the gospel"

It means that you obeyed the gospel

- What does it mean to be a Christian?
 - It means that you've been forgiven of your past trespasses
 - Romans 6:7
 - Romans 4:7-8
 - Colossians 2:13

- It means that you died to sin, and you are walking in newness of life
 - Ephesians 2:1
 - You were dead <u>in</u> sin before you became a Christian
 - Colossians 1:21
 - Alienated and enemies of God
 - Romans 6:2
 - Now dead to sin
 - Romans 6:11
 - Now you are alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord
 - Colossians 1:19-20
 - At peace with God
 - Romans 6:4
 - Now walking in newness of life
 - Galatians 2:20
 - "How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it?"

- It means that you have changed masters
 - Romans 6:13, 16-19
 - You are presenting yourself to God and your members as instruments of righteousness to God
 - Romans 6:19
 - The fruit is holiness
 - Romans 6:22-23
 - The wages is everlasting life
 - By contrast, the wages from the former master was death
 - Romans 6:12
 - Sin must not reign in your body, that you should obey its lusts

- It means that you are in a new relationship in subjection to the authority of Christ
 - Romans 6:2
 - Into Christ Jesus
 - Colossians 1:18; 2:19
 - He is your Head
 - Ephesians 5:24
 - Ephesians 1:22
