- A study of the Holy Spirit is important to the Christian because of the false doctrines that are taught about Him and are prevalent today. Those doctrines lead men away from conversion to Christ, away from true worship of God, and away from walking by faith.
- We should go to the Scriptures for a knowledge and understanding of the Holy Spirit, for the Scriptures contain His own testimony concerning Himself.
- Our study concerns the Holy Spirit, but because the word "spirit" in the Bible does not always refer to the Holy Spirit, we must be careful to not apply to the Holy Spirit the Scriptures which speak of another spirit, and we must be careful to apply to the Holy Spirit only those Scriptures that speak of the Holy Spirit.


The Holy Spirit is not some mystical being or simply and influence or force.

Ite performs the works of divine power, He possesses the attributes of God, and His works and characteristics show Him to be of the divine nature.

 The Holy Spirit is God just as much as the Father and Jesus Christ the Son are God.

Each of these three possesses all the qualities and attributes of divinity, and each is called God

- The Father John 6:27, 44-45; 20:17; 1 Corinthians 1:3; 8:6
- The Son, Jesus Christ John 1:1, 14; 20:28-29; Titus 2:13; Hebrews 1:8-9
- The Holy Spirit Acts 5:3-4; Ephesians 4:30
- The Father is not the Son, and the Son is not the Father, and neither the Father nor the Son is the Spirit. Each is a distinct being, possessing all the qualities of deity.
- For your consideration, it has been explained in this way:
 - All of these divine beings together constitute the one God, or the godhead. As there is one man (humanity or mankind), so there is one God (divinity, or godhood). As there are individual beings in one humanity, there are individual beings in one godhead.



Every member of the Godhead has a part in the singular purpose of the redemption of man

Ephesians 3:1-11
The Father – 3:6; 1:3-6
The Son – 3:11; 1:7-9
The Holy Spirit – 3:5-7; 1:8-10

The Holy Spirit is a person in the Godhead, just as is Jesus Christ the Son and God the Father.

We may not be able to comprehend how it can be, but we can accept it by faith because it is written. The things revealed are for us to know; the secret things belong to God.

 The Bible does not teach one individual in the Godhead manifesting Himself in three ways, nor does it teach three different gods.

Activities of the Holy Spirit in the Old Testament 2 Timothy 3:14-17

"But abide thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them; and that from a babe thou hast known the sacred writings which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Every scripture inspired of God is also profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for instruction which is in righteousness: that the man of God may be complete, furnished completely unto every good work."
