Colossians

• <u>Chapter 1</u>

- Christ the head of all things in creation and redemption
 - Paul's prayer for the Colossians (3-12)
 - The superiority of Christ (13-23)
 - Paul's joy in his sufferings and labors for Christ (24-29)
- <u>Chapter 2</u>
- Be not be led away from Christ the head of all things
 - Walk in Christ as you have received Him (1-7)
 - Do not be led away from Christ, you are complete in Him (8-12)
 - Christ is the fulfillment of the law (13-23)
- <u>Chapter 3</u>
 - Set your minds on the things above/Put off the old man (1-17)
 - Responsibilities in the family and workplace (18-25)



Colossians 2:20-23

- If you have died with Christ from the elementary principles of the world, that is the Law of Moses...
 - Why do you submit yourselves to things of the Law?
 - Such as, do not: Touch, taste, handle
 - Referring to observances of the Law, Not touching a dead body or things offered to idols
 - Not tasting forbidden meats, etc.
 - These things are now the commands and doctrines of men
 - They have the appearance of wisdom, but there is no value in them

Colossians 3:1-4

- Raised up with Christ (Col 2:12)
 - Seek the things above
 - Set your minds on the things above (Rom 2:6-11, 8:6)
 - Not on things of this world (1 John 2:15-17;Heb 11:14-16)
 - You have died to the things of this world (Phil 1:21;Gal 2:20)
 - When Christ appears, we will appear with Him (1 John 3:2)
 - Christ is our life (1 John 5:12;Phil1:21;Gal 2:20)

Colossians 3:5-11

- Put on the new self (Eph 4:20-32)
 - You are dead to the things of the world and must put these things away (Rom 13:12-14; James 1:12-16; 2 Pet 2:20-22)
 - Fornication/immorality, uncleanness/impurity, passion, evil desire, greed/covetousness which is idolatry, anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy/slander, filthy language/abusive speech, lying, evil practices
 - You have put on the new man
 - Renewed in knowledge according to Christ (Rom 12:1-2)
 - In Christ, there is no distinction, for Christ is all and in all
