II. Why this exhortation?

- a. Inclination to look down upon the young
 - i. Can be the fault of Timothy or of his audience
 - ii. Solution: be an example of what you teach

- a. Word, speech

- iii. Titus 2:6-8
- b. Conduct, manner of living
 - i. 1 Peter 1:14-18

- c. Charity, love
 - i. Some Greek words for love: storge = natural affection; phileo-= bond of friendship;
 eros = romantic or sexual love
 - ii. But the charity or love of this context: agape selfless love seeking the welfare of its object
