II. Enoch walked with God

- a. Walk = how you live daily; With – in fellowship with
- b. Cannot walk with God outside of Christ
 - i. Colossians 1:9-11
- c. Walk with God only through Christ
 - i. John 14:6
 - ii. Galatians 3:26-27
- d. Cannot walk with God living in sin
 - i. Ephesians 4:17-24
- e. Walk with God according to the doctrine of Christ
 - i. 2 John, esp. vss. 9, 6
- f. Walk by faith
 - i. 2 Corinthians 5:7
 - ii. Romans 10:17
 - iii. Colossians 2:6-7
 - iv. Need to have our beliefs right in order to walk right
 1. John 8:32
 2. John 13:17
 3. 3 John 4
 - v. Involves diligently seeking
 1. Hebrews 11:6

III. Enoch was a prophet of God.

- a. Prophet = mouthpiece of God
 - i. Hebrews 1:1
 - ii. Number 24:13
 - iii. A human instrument or agent for God
- b. No prophets today, but we are to yield/present our members to God
- c. Present your body
 - i. Acts 20:28
 - ii. Ephesians 1:14
 - iii. Romans 12:1

- iv. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20
- v. 1 Thessalonians 4:3-7
- d. Present the members of your body
 - i. Romans 6:13
 - ii. Your mind (attitude, thoughts, etc.) – 1 Peter 1:13-16; Matthew 5:28-29
 - iii. Your hands (what you are busy with and devoted to doing) – Ephesians 4:28; James 4:8; 1 Timothy 2:8
 - iv. Your feet – Romans 3:15, 10:15
 - v. Your tongue – Romans 3:13-14; James 3:5, 10
- e. Attitude of the prophets we should emulate
 - i. Cannot go beyond the word of the Lord – Numbers 24:13
 - ii. Cannot be bought – Numbers 24:13
 - iii. Will stay true to the word even out of season – 2 Chronicles 18:7, 12-13
 - 1. 2 Timothy 4:2

IV. Enoch had this testimony, that he pleased God

 - i. Consider the compliments given to many
 - ii. Greatest – from God – “you pleased Me” – Matthew 25:21

 - ii. We have a book of testimony
 - 1. Like Israel did – Isaiah 8:20
 - 2. 1 Corinthians 2:1; 2 Timothy 1:8
 - iii. Romans 8:16
 - iv. Assured of this:
 - 1. John 12:48; Romans 2:16

V. God will reward those who diligently seek Him, walking by faith.

- b. Walk with God by walking in Jesus Christ, putting off the old man of sin, abiding in His doctrine, walking by faith.
- c. Present yourself a living sacrifice unto God, yielding your members to righteousness.
- d. Know that He rewards those who diligently seek Him.
