
The duration of miraculous, spiritual gifts

 Since they could only be imparted to other saints through the laying on of the apostles' hands, they were not perpetual in duration.

Remember their purpose:

- To reveal all truth. All truth was revealed to the apostles and prophets.
- To confirm the word. The word has been confirmed.
- 1 Corinthians 13:8-13 tells when miraculous, spiritual gifts would cease. They would cease when that which is perfect has come. That which is perfect is the complete will of God in Christ Jesus, the New Testament.
