- Greatest separation
 - Matthew 25:32
- Verdict will be final
 - Matthew 25:46
- Necessarily implies purpose, responsibility, accountability
 - Matthew 25:15, 19
 - Romans 4:11-12
 - 2 Corinthians 5:10

- Remember your Creator
 - Ecclesiastes 12:1
- Respond to the gospel

 - 2 Corinthians 5:14-15
