- One of three parables on this occasion about the coming of the Son of Man
 Destruction of Jerusalem 24:1-35
 Coming of the Son of Man at end of time 24:36 25:46
 - Parable of the faithful servant and the evil servant
 - Parable of the wise and foolish virgins
 - Parable of the talents
 - Son of Man coming in final judgment

1. Every person must take responsibility for self

"Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out"

You cannot buy, transfer, give to another, take from another, share righteousness
Ezekiel 18:20b; Revelation 3:18
You are <u>responsible</u> individually to obey the gospel and remain faithful
John 21:21-22; Acts 2:38; Philippians 2:12
You are <u>accountable</u> for yourself
Romans 14:11-12

1. Every person must take responsibility for self

"Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out"

You cannot blame others for your choices
Ezekiel 18:1-3
Will not be saved by association
Revelation 3:3-5
Your name must be in the Book of Life
Revelation 20:12-15; Exodus 32:30-33

2. It is not enough to begin – You must finish

"Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps"

You can be close to the kingdom, yet miss it
 Mark 12:34; Acts 13:46

You cannot rest on past accomplishments

Hebrews 10:32-39; Revelation 2:4-5

Your greatest desire must be to enter in
 Philippians 2:21-23; 3:13-14

2. It is not enough to begin – You must finish

"Those who were foolish took their lamps and took no oil with them, but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps"

You can fall away and lose your reward
Galatians 5:4; Hebrews 10:26-27; 2 Peter 3:17
You must give diligent effort in order to finish
1 Corinthians 9:24-27; 2 Timothy 4:7-8

3. There are no second chances

"And the door was shut"

As in the days of Noah

Genesis 7:7, 16, 21

No purgatory, no baptism for the dead

2 Corinthians 5:10

Death shuts the door

Luke 16:22-23; Hebrews 9:27

Door not re-opened

- ► v.11-12
- It is the finality of all finalities
 - ▶ Revelation 22:14-15

"Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming"

Saved now, but want to be saved in eternity
Romans 13:11; 2 Peter 1:10-11; 1 Corinthians 15:1-2
We know not the hour nor the day
Matthew 24:36, 44
That day will come suddenly
1 Corinthians 15:51-52; 1 Thessalonians 4:16; 5:2-3
Delay in man's estimation really means opportunity to repent
2 Peter 3:3-13

- ▶ In that day, there will be many unprepared
 - There will be some who did many good deeds but were never in Christ
 - There will be some who were baptized into Christ but then did not live the life of a Christian
 - There will be some who were obedient to Christ for many years but later became unfaithful
 - There will be some who did many wonderful works but practiced lawlessness
 - There will be some who became bitter over some offense suffered from others

In that day, there will be many unprepared

- There will be some who have become proud, rejecting all entreaties of brethren, separating themselves from brethren and committing themselves to a never-ending death spiral
- There will be some who suppose another's worse evil makes theirs ok
- There will be some who started hot but grew cold
- There will be some who grew indifferent, apathetic, lukewarm
- There will be some who became entangled in the affairs of this life

- You don't need to be mean and ugly to be unprepared
- You don't need to live in the most heinous sin to be unprepared
- You don't need to become a denominationalist or a Calvinist or a Catholic or a Mormon or a Muslim to be unprepared
- You don't need to openly deny the Lord Jesus Christ to be unprepared
- You don't need to become an agnostic to be unprepared
- You don't need to become an atheist to be unprepared

All that's required of you in order to be unprepared is to be NEGLIGENT

Hebrews 2:1-4

"Those who were ready went in with him to the wedding"
