## The Parable of the Laborers in the Vineyard

MATTHEW 20:1-16

- ▶ Context begins in 19:16
- The parable of the laborers in the vineyard is told as further explanation
- Significant elements of the parable
  - ▶ A landowner God
  - ▶ His vineyard the church, the kingdom of God
  - ▶ Went out to hire the gospel call goes out
  - ▶ Laborers men and women of all ages
  - ▶ Laborers hired at different times of the day men and women called by the gospel at different times and ages
  - ▶ Payment came at end of day reward given at end of life's day
  - ▶ Same reward for all
  - ▶ Attitude of the first-hired exposed and condemned

- 1. Need to be in the Lord's kingdom
- 2. Need to *labor* in the Lord's kingdom in order to receive the reward
- 3. The same reward regardless of start time
- 4. God is good
- 5. Watch your attitude in the kingdom of God
- 6. Respond to the gospel when called
